That's why we established the DXC Dandelion Program in Australia and New Zealand in 2014, to embrace, support and expand the skills of neurodiverse people, and help them secure long-term, fulfilling IT careers.

The program recruits neurodiverse people, provides training across various technologies and matches their skills to unique placements within DXC's customer organisations.

Throughout the program, DXC offers comprehensive career guidance, onsite support and training to give neurodiverse people the confidence to flourish in the workplace.
